HOW DO YOU WANT TO COMPLETE ADULT LEADER TRAINING?

Go to my.scouting.org and set up a Personal Record profile. Then **take Youth Protection training**. All registered adult leaders must complete this training, and it must be retaken every two years.

IN PERSON: Check with your local council and sign up for the next available **leader position-specific training** offered for your volunteer role. The position-specific session is the main course you'll need to be considered trained for your volunteer role.

ONLINE: Log in to my.scouting.org and view the learning plan that appears in your profile. This plan is tailored specifically to your volunteer position and offers a series of interactive training videos. Complete the lessons in your learning plan at your convenience, and revisit these videos anytime you need to refresh your knowledge of these subjects. Boy Scout leaders will need to complete an in-person Introduction to Outdoor Leadership Skills before earning a Trained patch.
